

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Harper College offers an outstanding education at an affordable cost. 11,661 students were awarded \$34,558,138 in scholarships, grants and tuition waivers through Harper College in 2023-24.

All students should apply each academic year for financial aid and Harper College scholarships. To be considered, the student must:

- Apply for financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa/>), a federal form - **or** - Undocumented students otherwise not eligible for federal financial aid can apply for state financial aid by completing the Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid (<https://studentportal.isac.org/en/alternativeapp/>)
